## 2020 Kindergarten Term 1 Newsletter

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to Narrabeen Lakes PS. The children have had a busy but fun first day. You will probably notice an increase in their tiredness over the next couple of weeks. It takes a lot of energy and concentration to learn the routines of school life. Early nights are a great idea for many children.

In the coming weeks the academic programs really take off. This will be reflected in the work that will come home. We look forward to seeing the growth in your children's enthusiasm and interest in learning.

### THE SOUNDS OF THE WEEK

The children will be learning these sounds, in this order, over the following weeks – a m s t i f p d.

In class, we find these sounds in words, write them down and blend them together to make words eg. 'as', 'at'. You can discuss each sound and look for examples of items beginning with each.

### NEWS (SHOW and TELL)

We will be starting News from Week 4 (17/2/20). Your child's News day and topics for the week are attached. Please have your child practise presenting their news at home before bringing it in to present to the class.

### HOME READERS

Our home reading program begins Week 4 (17/2/20). Our home readers are distributed and changed on Mondays and Fridays. On each of these days, the children choose 4 books, one for each day until the next changeover. Children change readers during class time.

At the start, the children will require lots of assistance to read the words. If your child is unwilling to 'read' the book themselves, please read the story to them while pointing to each word. As they learn more, you will notice them attempting to "sound out" words. They will also start seeing their sight words and repeated words in the texts. Your involvement in this reading session is most appreciated. Please note; your child will only be given readers when they bring in their maroon reading pouches.

### HOME READING LOG

After your child has read please fill in the Home Reading Log. This should be left in the home reading bag for your teacher to sign off after 10, 20, 30 up to 300 days. The school rewards students for their home reading. It is advisable to keep this in a plastic zip lock bag. It is up to children to present to the teacher.

### SIGHT WORDS

In Week 5 (24/2/20) your child will be given the 'golden words'. This is the first set of sight words from the Magic 100 sight word list (M100W). The children need to learn these words so they can be automatically recalled when reading books. The teacher will assess your child to see if they have automatic (reading without sounding out) knowledge of these words. The teacher will assess these words in random order. As soon as the 'Champion Golden Words' are mastered, the children receive a certificate and they are then given the next set of words. Once they complete 100 words and then 200 words they receive a certificate at our K-2 assembly on Friday.

### ALLERGIES - No nuts or nut products

We have several children at school with severe allergies. Please do not send any nut products to school. Also talk to your children about the importance of not sharing food at school. If your child has an allergy please see your teacher and the office to ensure that the school is aware.

### CRUNCH and SIP

Every morning classes will partake in Crunch and Sip. The children bring their food into the classroom first thing in the morning. They are allowed to eat a piece of fruit or vegetables during this time (no packaged fruit products) and drink water only. It is a valuable initiative which is followed by the whole school. Please ensure that the food is quick to eat and your child can eat it unassisted.

### HOMEWORK

Homework in Term 1 will consist of

- Home reading (weekly)
- Sight words (to be done at your child's individual pace)
- News preparation (fortnightly)

Tuesday	KS and KD - Library
Thursday	Gross Motor/Fitness activities <b>(Please wear sports uniform)</b> KH - Library
Friday	Home reader swapping K-2 assembly (odd weeks of term only)

Please bring library bags in on library days.

## SPORT DAY

Please note that Kindergarten sport day is Thursday. The children should wear sport uniform on Tuesday only.

## PENCIL GRIPS

We have been doing quite a bit of drawing and writing this week. Some of the children are finding some difficulty in holding their pencils correctly (tripod grip). The best way to remedy this is lots of practise using a moulded pencil grip. These are used at school but regular practise using them at home would be of great benefit. Good quality grips are available at newsagencies. Ask your class teacher to show you one if you are unsure of which kind to buy.

## SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Thank you for providing your children with the correct school uniform including school hats, with names clearly written. Hats are worn whenever the children are outside. Please note that without a hat, your child will need to spend recess and lunchtimes under the shade structures. This restricts their much needed play time. If your child is unable to wear the correct uniform please write a note for the teacher.

## YEAR 6 BUDDIES

What fabulous buddies we have! They will care for and introduce your children to our school. It is always a highlight when the buddies come to visit! Please find out your child's buddy and say hello.

## LITERACY GROUPS

Keep your eye out for a request for parental help in our morning literacy group sessions. This is a great opportunity to get involved with your child's reading and to see

some of the games and activities that we use at school. We look forward to your involvement in the classroom.
