


Special Swimming Scheme

As part of our PE program, Year 4 and Year 2 students will be participating in the Special Swimming Scheme from Monday 6 March—Friday 10 March.

As Year 4 leave at 9:00am, children will need to **wear their swimming costume each day, under mufti clothing**, but bring a change of underwear and their school uniform, which they will change into on arrival back at school, so they are not wearing a wet costume all day. Year 2 will change before they leave school at 10:20am.

All children **MUST** also bring sunscreen, a hat and a towel in a small bag. Please DO NOT send these in a plastic bag, as they tear easily. Goggles may be brought, if required. Please ensure all items are named.

As students are walking to and from the pool, enclosed shoes **MUST** be worn—NO thongs or Crocs are allowed. Students **MUST** wear suitable mufti clothing to and from the pool. They can not just have a towel wrapped around themselves.

Swim Scheme caters for all ability levels, from non-swimmers to competent swimmers. Specialised swimming instructors give appropriate lessons, depending on the abilities of the students in each group.
