### **English**

'In English, students learn to read, write, speak, view and represent language. They learn about the English language and literature through working with a wide range of interesting texts. Students learn how language varies according to context, and how to communicate with a range of audiences for different purposes. They learn to read for information and pleasure. Students gain a sound grasp of language structures, punctuation, spelling and grammar. They also learn to think in ways that are imaginative, creative and critical.' (Parent Guide to the NSW Primary Syllabuses)

### **Mathematics**

There will be a strong focus on teaching all students to have a positive attitude towards mathematics tasks and to believe that they are mathematicians. 'Differentiated lessons in all strands of the NSW Mathematics syllabus will be undertaken each week. Mathematics focuses on developing students' mathematical understanding, fluency, communication, reasoning and problem-solving through their study of Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, and Statistics and Probability. These capabilities enable students to respond to familiar and unfamiliar situations, using strategies to make decisions and solve problems relevant to their further education and everyday lives.' (Parent Guide to the NSW Primary Syllabuses)

### **SPORT**

This year we will continue to have sport on a **FRIDAY**. Can all children please wear their sports uniform on this day.

### **Library and Home Readers**

Students will need to bring their library bags and home reader bags to school from Week Two. Library day will be on Tuesdays.

### Homework

During Term One, homework will focus on reading every day. Please make sure your child has a home reader bag so they can start borrowing as soon as possible. Don't forget to send in the Home Reading Logbook after 10 days of reading.

### A few reminders

- Please make sure that notes are provided for absences within 7 days after the absence has occurred.
- Please make sure that ALL of your child's property is clearly labelled, including clothing and personal items.
- Birthdays Iceblocks are always welcome (and preferred as they are individually wrapped). For your
  convenience these can be ordered through Flexischools Canteen ordering and will be delivered to the
  classroom by the canteen.

Soon, each teacher will send home the QR code for you to connect to SEESAW. We will be continuing this form of communication for messages this year so please make sure you sign the 'permission to publish' note and connect as soon as you receive your specific code so you don't miss out on any messages or posts about class activities. 
